- 5. Describe your ideal assistant. What do you think is the most important thing you need help from the assistant in your life?
- 6. What types of items do you use on a daily basis? Why?

Usage (10-15 minutes)

- 1. Have you used voice assistants before? If so, what voice assistant devices have you/do you use? For what purpose? (Operating system/How long have you used it?)
- 2. How would you describe your relationship with [voice assistant device]?
- 3. Tell me about your experience using voice assistants.
 - a. Follow up worst or best? Happy or frustrating?
- 4. What do you typically use [voice assistant device] for?
- 5. How often do you use [voice assistant device]?
 - a. Follow up What time?

Feedback (5-10 minutes)

- 1. How do your interactions with [voice assistant device] make you feel and why?
 - a. What do you think of the feedback provided by [voice assistant device] during and after a task?
- 2. How do [voice assistant device]'s sounds make you feel?
